LIFE-Nature 2000-2001 — Call for proposals

(2000/C 161/03)

The Commission invites 'natural or legal persons' established in the European Union or in the candidate countries associated to LIFE to present proposals for the LIFE-Nature selection round 2000-2001. Candidate countries associated to LIFE can take part in this round according to the provisions set up in the decisions by the Association Councils concerning their participation in LIFE. For the moment only Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Romania and Slovenia have decided to participate.

This call is conditional on the final adoption of the new LIFE regulation.

Projects eligible for LIFE-Nature funding:

Projects aiming at the conservation of natural habitats and of wild fauna and flora of Community and (for candidate countries only) international interest.

Applications:

Proposals must be written on specific application forms. The application file that includes detailed explanations with regard to eligibility and procedures, as well as the required application forms can be obtained from the national competent authorities (see tables) who will also be able to give the necessary information on classified/proposed Natura 2000 sites or from the Commission's web-site on the following address:

Available languages: all official Community languages.

Where and when to submit a project:

Each project must be submitted, in four copies, to the competent national authority, except in the following particular cases:

- **Germany:** to the competent Länder ministries, who will then forward them to the Federal Ministry.
- **France:** to the competent DIREN (Directions Régionales de l'Environnement), who will then forward them to the Ministry of the Environment.
- **Austria:** to the competent Länder ministries, who will then forward them to the coordinating Länder representative for nature protection matters. All projects shall be submitted to the national competent authorities at the latest by 30 September 2000.

Projects will then be submitted (two copies) by the national authorities to the Commission at the latest by 31 October 2000.

Member States and candidate countries associated to LIFE may change the national submission deadline and the total number of copies required. It will be up to them to inform the public consequently.
