Prior notification of a concentration
(Case COMP/M.4489 — 3i/Countrywide)
Candidate case for simplified procedure

(Text with EEA relevance)

1. On 4 January 2007, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 ⁽¹⁾ by which the 3i Group plc ('3i', UK), through the holding company Charlie Holdco 4 Limited, acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking Countrywide plc ('Countrywide', UK) by way of a public bid.

2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

— for 3i: a private investment firm;

— for Countrywide: the provision of services in the residential property sector.

3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of Regulation (EC) No 139/2004. However, the final decision on this point is reserved. Pursuant to the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 ⁽²⁾ it should be noted that this case is a candidate for treatment under the procedure set out in the Notice.

4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
